Explanation of Services

Professional & Staff Services:

Coordinating Activities, Rites and Ceremonies

- Includes 24-hour staff availability, initial pre or at need arrangements and aftercare. This fee also covers the costs associated with maintaining our facilities, utilities, taxes, insurance and licences.
- Professional consultation with a Class One Licenced Funeral Director, including, but not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your needs.
- Co-ordination of all activities, rites and ceremonies, before, during and after they have been provided. Co-ordination of services and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by third party suppliers, such as florists and newspapers (death notices). \$995

Documentation – Permits, Forms etc...

- Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation and/or documentation necessary to transfer the deceased out of the country.
- Provision of 8 Proof of Death Certificates issued by Bocchinfuso Funeral Home Inc.
- Also included:
 - ✓ Cancellation of all government cards (SIN, Health Card, OAS Card, Pleasure Craft Operator Card, Outdoors Card [Fishing and Hunting Licence], Firearms Licence)
 - ✓ Preparation and filing of the CPP Death Benefit Application
 - ✓ Preparation and filing of the CPP Survivors Benefit Application (for Spouse and applicable Children)
 - ✓ Notification sent to Canada Pension Plan and Old Age Security \$550

Transportation of Deceased Remains (within 25kms; additional fee applies beyond 25kms)

- Staff services for transportation of remains from one place to another. For example, from a hospital to the funeral home, or from the funeral home to the cemetery, mausoleum or crematorium. A charge applies for each transportation request. \$245

Basic Preparation of Deceased Remains (Requires Facilities for Preparation/Embalming/Shelter)

- The preparation of the body for placement into the casket, including bathing, dressing and the setting of facial features for identification or viewing without embalming and checking remains for personal effects, jewellery and pacemaker. This charge applies whenever we handle deceased remains. \$185

Embalming of Deceased Remains and Preparation for Viewing (In addition to Basic Preparation of Remains)

- Embalming is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs.
- Includes dressing, casketing, hairdressing, grooming and cosmetics \$245

Removal of Pacemaker or Implanted devices \$ 75

Staff Services for Visitation

- Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation for a period up to four hours. \$400

Staff Services for Ceremony

- Staff to coordinate and oversee the Funeral Mass, Funeral Service, Memorial Service or Ceremony for up to 2 hours. \$300

Facilities for Preparation/ Embalming/ Shelter

- Facilities used to prepare, embalm and shelter the body; this charge applies whenever the body is in our facility, for any purpose. \$250

Facilities for Visitation

(Requires Staff Services for Visitation)

- Designated facilities used for visitation for a period up to four hours. \$400
- Additional Visitation - each 2 hours \$250

Facilities for Ceremony /Offsite Ceremony

(Requires Staff Services for Ceremony)

- Designated facilities used for the ceremony or memorial service up to two hours.
- Use of all necessary equipment required to fulfill the needs of the family for funeral service in a church, chapel or other facility \$400

Vehicles

Lead/Administrative and Clergy Vehicle

- Automobile used to transport staff for arrangements, services, obtain and deliver documents, transport clergy, and lead funeral processions. \$195

Transfer Vehicle

- An **unmarked vehicle** used to transfer a deceased person from place of death to funeral establishment or to the crematorium. \$185

Funeral Coach

- Used in funerals to transport casket to place of funeral service and to the cemetery, mausoleum or crematorium \$435

Limousine (Up to Three Hours)

- A car that holds up to seven people. Used for the immediate family, mainly in funeral processions, when going to a place of funeral service or to a cemetery. \$435
- A car that holds up to nine people. \$475

ADDITIONAL TRANSPORTATION CHARGES

Lead, transfer vehicle or funeral coach in excess of 25 Kilometers (per vehicle) \$1.75/km

Additional time (fee applies after 3 hours) (per vehicle, per half hour) \$ 50

Transportation to any crematorium/cemetery other than Bayview Crematorium \$100

Funeral Director and vehicle to interment of cremated remains \$185

Memorial Boat Ride, weather and season permitting \$185

Refundable Cremated Remains Deposit

DISBURSMENTS

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf, by the funeral home. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements:

Coroner's Fee: This is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Clergy Honourarium: This is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases, the amount is set by the clergy – considered a "Clergy Fee", in other cases, it is an amount to be determined by you and would be considered an honourarium or offering.

Newspaper Notices: These are charges for death notices placed in newspapers.

Luncheons: The funeral home can arrange for a luncheon following your services.

Cemetery Fees: The cemetery, chosen by the family, charges a set fee for the opening and closing of the grave, and may have additional weekend or holiday charges. Each cemetery has different set amounts. Cemetery fees must be paid directly to the cemetery.

Municipal Death Registration Fee: This fee is charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality.

Cremation Fee: Price set by crematorium of your choice.

PAYMENT, FINANCING AND FUNDING

At Need Payment: The Purchaser will be required to make a 30% deposit at the time of signing the contract for funeral services plus any cash disbursements. The balance of the contract is due within 16 days of signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash, cheque or money order.

Pre-Paid Arrangement Payment: When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today. The funds deposited plus the interest accrued will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death. If there is any money left due to the interest earned, it will be refunded to the estate. A T-5 will also be issued. Should you cancel the contract after 30 days, you will be charged an administration fee in the amount of 10% of the prepayment funds, up to a maximum of \$350.00.

Trust: You make your payment in full to us or provide a cancelled cheque for monthly payments and we will place this money in a trust account where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled.

Insurance: You may purchase an insurance contract where the proceeds of the insurance contract will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered, or the contract is cancelled.
